我要把我的教會建造在這磐石上。-馬太福音 16章 18節

巴西一間公司的經理要大廈所有的清潔人員都提交書面報告，因為她要知道每天誰負責清理了哪些房間，哪些房間尚未清掃，以及打掃每個房間需要多少時間。一週後，她才收到這些理應每天都呈上的書面報告，而且並不完整。

這位經理調查後，才發現大部分的清潔員都不識字。她大可辭掉他們，但她卻為他們安排了識字班。五個月後，每個人都有了基本的閱讀能力，且能繼續工作。

上帝經常使用我們的缺點或不足，成為裝備我們的機會，使我們能繼續為祂工作。在彼得的一生中，他經常犯錯也經驗不足。他試著在水面上行走，卻信心動搖；他不確定耶穌是否應該納了稅（馬太福音 17章 24-27節）；當基督預言，祂將被釘十字架及第三日復活，彼得卻拒絕接受（16章 21-23節）。耶穌透過這些事情讓彼得更加明白，耶穌就是上帝所應許的彌賽亞（16節）。彼得從這些事件中學習並領受耶穌的教導，使他日後得以建立初代教會（18節）。

倘若你今天因失敗而氣餒，別忘了耶穌可以藉此教導你並裝備你，使你更有效地服事祂。即使彼得有缺點，耶穌仍繼續與他同工，同樣地祂也能使用我們繼續建造祂的國度，直至祂再臨。

- Acts 6:1** Now in these days when the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint by the Hellenists arose against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution.
- Acts 6:2** And the twelve summoned the full number of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables.
- Acts 6:3** Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty.
- Acts 6:4** But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word."
- Acts 6:5** And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch.
- Acts 6:6** These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands on them.
- Acts 6:7** And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith.

威廉·克里 (William Carey, 1761-1834 年) 在英國的鄉村長大，同鄉的人可能都想不到他日後會有如此成就，甚至被譽為「近代宣教士之父」。克理的雙親皆為織布工，他自己則是個鞋匠，也曾當過短期的教師，並自學希臘文、希伯來文和拉丁文。多年後，他實現了去印度宣教的夢想，但卻面對極大的困難。他的兒子離世，妻子因受打擊而精神失常，而他服事多年的民眾對福音依然冷淡。

在如此艱難的環境中，為何克里還能將整本聖經翻譯成 6 種語言，並將部分聖經譯為另外 29 種語言呢？他說：「我可以辛勤苦幹，只要有明確的目標我就會堅持到底。」不論遭遇何種試煉，他總是忠心地事奉上帝。

忠心服事基督，正是希伯來書的作者對信徒的勸勉。他呼籲讀者，要使上帝得榮耀就不可「懈怠」（希伯來書 6 章 12 節），而是要殷勤（11 節）。他重申上帝並沒有忘記他們所做的工，以及他們為祂的名所表現的愛心（10 節）。

威廉·克里在晚年時回顧上帝如何持續供應他的需要，他說：「上帝的應許絕不落空，因此我事奉祂也不能失職。」願上帝加添力量給我們，讓我們能天天忠心服事祂。

7/27/2019 Morning Session

- Acts 2:1** When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.  
**Acts 2:2** And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.  
**Acts 2:3** And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them.  
**Acts 2:4** And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.  
**Acts 2:5** Now there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven.  
**Acts 2:6** And at this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one was hearing them speak in his own language.  
**Acts 2:7** And they were amazed and astonished, saying, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans?"  
**Acts 2:8** And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language?  
**Acts 2:9** Parthians and Medes and Elamites and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia,  
**Acts 2:10** Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome,  
**Acts 2:11** both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians—we hear them telling in our own tongues the mighty works of God."  
**Acts 2:12** And all were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?"  
**Acts 2:13** But others mocking said, "They are filled with new wine."  
**Acts 2:36** Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."  
**Acts 2:37** Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"  
**Acts 2:38** And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.  
**Acts 2:39** For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself."  
**Acts 2:40** And with many other words he bore witness and continued to exhort them, saying, "Save yourselves from this crooked generation."  
**Acts 2:41** So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.  
**Acts 2:42** And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.  
**Acts 2:43** And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.  
**Acts 2:44** And all who believed were together and had all things in common.  
**Acts 2:45** And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need.  
**Acts 2:46** And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts,  
**Acts 2:47** praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

**Acts 1:1-11**

1. Spend a few minutes preparing your heart for our time together in God's Word this weekend and for this morning's devotional. What is on your mind or heart that may be distracting you from hearing what God has to say to you? Commit and entrust these to God in prayer and inviting him into this time with you.

2. Read Acts 1:1-11 through 2-3 times. What stands out to you?

3. In v. 6, the disciples ask Jesus if he is going to, "restore the kingdom to Israel." By this they mean an eternal kingdom where God reigns and the people have perfect shalom. In a way their hope is right: this is what we as Christians hope for when Christ returns and Christ already won the eternal victory on the cross. In other ways their hope is wrong: they want the kingdom immediately and they think it will be socio-political and that they might be rewarded for following Jesus with places of prominence and prestige in the new kingdom.

- a. What are some ways our hope in God might be too small or distant in our everyday lives?
- b. How might your life change if you truly lived like you believe that Christ will return and restore shalom and that he still reigns in our lives?

Jesus tells his disciples in v. 8 that they will receive power from the Holy Spirit and that they will be his witnesses in Jerusalem, in all of Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. Then Jesus ascends and it's a full week before the Holy Spirit descends.

- . Why do you think Jesus waited that week? How do you think the disciples felt during this week of waiting? How would you have felt if you were in their shoes?
- a. What are some areas in your life where you experience anxiety or fear around uncertainty? What are some areas in your life where you need power from the Holy Spirit? Spend some time jotting these down and committing them to Jesus in prayer.
